

OLD TESTAMENT READING – Proverbs 9:1-10 Wisdom has built her house; she has hewn her seven pillars. ² She has slaughtered her beasts; she has mixed her wine; she has also set her table. ³ She has sent out her young women to call from the highest places in the town, ⁴ "Whoever is simple, let him turn in here!" To him who lacks sense she says, ⁵ "Come, eat of my bread and drink of the wine I have mixed. ⁶ Leave your simple ways, and live, and walk in the way of insight." ⁷ Whoever corrects a scoffer gets himself abuse, and he who reproves

SERMON - 2 Thessalonians 1:1-10 (NIV) Paul, Silas and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: ² Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. 3 We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing. ⁴ Therefore, among God's churches we boast about your perseverance and faith in all the persecutions and trials you are enduring. 5 All this is evidence that God's judgment is right, and as a result you will be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are suffering. ⁶ God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you ⁷ and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. 8 He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. 9 They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might 10 on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at among all those who have believed. This includes you, because you believed our testimony to you.

in Eau Claire, Wisconsin. Pastor Ted Barthels served as Chaplain. Pastor David Ude presented an Exegesis paper on 2 Thessalonians 1:1ff; Pastor Paul Tiefel presented an essay entitled: 'Is Agreement on Historical Perspective Necessary for God-Pleasing Fellowship? Pastor Paul D. Nolting presented a report on 'In Statu Confessionis' in Light of the Inter-Synod Discussions.' Pastor John Hein presented a Review of the Document, 'Theses and Antitheses on the Termination of Fellowship.' The Board of Doctrine presented an Analysis of the Joint Statement including a study of Skopein and the responses of the ELS/WELS to the Questions of CLC Clergy. After lengthy discussion, the CLC General Pastoral Conference voted to recommend that the Joint Statement on the Termination of Fellowship produced by a 9-Man committee (3 CLC, 3 ELS, 3 WELS) not be adopted by the CLC because it is insufficient as a resolution of the long-standing doctrinal differences between the CLC and the WELS/ELS. If you have any questions about the papers or the recommendation, please speak with Pastor Rodebaugh.
